Initiate Response

Example situation: Individual is found on the floor and is not responding to name or hard tapping of shoulders.

Responder Actions:

1. First responder calls for help.
2. First responder begins CPR.
3. First responder instructs second responder to immediately call 911 and tell office staff there is an unresponsive child/adult at (location). OR Office staff calls 911 and uses notification system to alert Cardiac Emergency Response Team (CERT) there is an unresponsive child/adult at (location).
4. Office calls for a "Hold". The students from the responders go to the alternate location (list the alternate locations (Alt Loc) next to the members on left) and the responders go immediately to the location of the victim.
5. CERT team immediately responds to victim and brings AED en route if it has not already been retrieved.
6. AED is immediately applied and used when needed/advised.
7. Assign someone to document all times and events of the CERT Team. Record:
 - Approx. time of the emergency call
 - Number of CPR Rounds (include breaths if being given)
 - Time AED applied
 - Number of and times of advised shocks
8. Assign someone to meet EMS at the assigned location and guide emergency medical services to the victim.
9. CERT Team continues CPR while documenter informs EMS of the details of the event. **Continue CPR until EMS takes over.**

Teacher or Staff Actions:

1. Secure a safe scene by instructing students to clear the area. (HOLD).
2. If you are a responder, direct students to go to alternate site immediately and respond to the victim.
3. If you are an alternate site, greet students, ensure all students are accounted for and reassure them. Begin alternate teaching plan.
4. Assure students remain in the classroom until an "all clear" announcement. If teacher assistance not required at the scene, continue teaching to maintain normalcy.
5. Debrief with students after event and refer students to counseling services as appropriate.
6. Seize the opportunity to review education about SCA, CPR and AEDs. Stress importance of not tampering with AEDs on campus.
